## Please help us make your exam comfortable and successful. Following these guidelines will assist us in making your exam quick and easy.

- Don't wear clothing that has metal decorations, metal fasteners, metal zippers or metal belt buckles around the abdominal area. These may interfere with the reading in the area where we are measuring your bone density.
- Please do not take vitamins, calcium supplements, Tums or Rolaids on the day of your test. These may cause an incorrect reading
  of your bone mineral density. PLEASE CONTINUE TO TAKE ALL PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS.
- If you've had any contrast media x-ray exams (i.e. Barium, Nuclear Medicine or MRI Studies) please wait at least two weeks to have your DXA exam.
- During the exam, you will be lying on your back on the scan table, which has a weight limit of 350 pounds. If you are unable to lie
  on your back or if your weight is over 350 pounds, we can still perform a DXA exam. We will scan your forearm instead of your
  spine and hips.
- For those of you who use a wheelchair, it may be helpful to know that our DXA table is 27 inches high. If you are unable to stand or transfer onto the table we will simply perform a forearm scan. Please let the technologist know what would be best for you. Our policy does not allow employees to lift patients onto the table.
- Please check with your insurance provider for coverage information. In general, DXA scans are covered every 2 years, sooner only
  if medically necessary.
- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your appointment if you have not done your paperwork at portal.ewbc.com.
- Your doctor will discuss your Bone Densitometry results with you.
- Please be aware that the International Society of Clinical Densitometry recommends that for the most accurate comparison to
  previous scans, your DXA exam should be performed on the same unit each time. Please let us know if you have had a prior DXA
  bone densitometry exam at another facility.
